## Here are just some of the must-do's to discover in Ipswich:

### Family Fun at The Workshops Rail Museum

You won't be able to drag the kids away from the interactive exhibits at The Workshops Rail Museum with a popular one being the Diesel Revolution where they take the controls of the diesel locomotive simulator. Then there's the ever-popular Nippers' Railway where the full gamut of rail experiences is on offer – drive a train, collect tickets, control signals and so much more. Hands on fun for everyone! Don't miss a Day out with Thomas from the 26 December 2016 to 22 January 2017.

### Ipswich Art Gallery

For a great day out with the kids make sure to visit the Ipswich Art Gallery. The Ipswich Art Gallery was the first in Australia to offer a dedicated Children's Gallery with an innovative programme including interactive exhibitions, dance and movement sessions, puppet shows and create-your own- art workshops.

### Queens Park and Ipswich Nature Centre

The magnificent Queens Park boasts enormous, shady trees dotted around the picturesque green expanse on the hill at the eastern entrance to the city. The Ipswich Nature Centre located in Queens Park, offers a magical opportunity to get up close and personal with Australian native wildlife, including a walk through bird aviary and a nocturnal bilby exhibit.

### Queensland Motorsport Museum

A motoring enthusiast's dream awaits at the Queensland Motorsport Museum in the centre of the Ipswich Central Brisbane District. Ipswich is the motor racing capital of south-east Queensland, with both Willowbank and Queensland Raceways on its outskirts, so the city is a great fit for this museum with its outstanding collection from motoring's past.

### Floating Images Hot Air Balloon

It's an early morning start, but why wouldn't you want to combine a magnificent sunrise, the romance and adventure of old-world transport and spectacular scenery in one memorable experience. Owner and chief pilot of Floating Images Hot Air Balloon Flights, Graeme Day knows what it takes to create a legion of enthusiastic fans who like their adrenalin rush a little on the softer side.

### Grandchester Model Steam Railway

Train enthusiasts young and old are spoilt for choice in Ipswich. When you arrive, it's like the hustle and bustle of a real railway station only the locomotives are scaled down versions of actual coal burning steam engines. This attraction is open on the first Sunday of the month.

### Queensland Pioneer Steam Railway

The romanticism of the steam train era awaits you in Ipswich courtesy of the Queensland Pioneer Steam Railway. Hop on board an immaculate vintage wooden carriage and discover the rich mining history of the Ipswich area as you go past ruins of old mines and equipment from days gone by.

### Rosewood Railway Museum

The Museum is an operating railway that includes a PB15 steam locomotive that hauls restored wooden carriages plus a variety of diesel locomotives and railmotors. The museum, part of the Australian Railway Historical Society Queensland Division, also has an extensive collection of restored carriages and wagons on display.

### Eating Out

Your spoilt for choice with trendy bars, live music, craft beer and great atmosphere. Head to the **Pumpyard Bar and Brewery**, this one uber-cool place combines craft beers brewed on site and great bar food in the atmosphere of a 100 year old industrial design building. Try their carrot beet, Wabbit Saison, or the new s'more inspired sweet stout, aptly named S'more than a feeling.

Nearby, **Heisenberg Haus** offers hearty German-fare. With Austrian chef Marcel Jaritz in the kitchen and premium German beers straight from some of the best breweries in Munich, Heisenberg Haus is a great addition to the dining and entertainment scene.

**Dusty's Bar and BBQ** celebrates all thing American with plenty of great memorabilia ranging from sporting to country and western. Live music on a Saturday night is complimented with mouthwatering American food ranging from the Boston Dog to Dusty's famous ribs, and a selection of American and Aussie beers.

If you are a true craft beer lover, head to **Tap'd** where they have 72 different beers and ciders on tap... variety is the spice of life after all.



### Events

CMC Rocks Queensland is the biggest international country and roots festival in the Southern Hemisphere. 
